Tulameen Community Club held its annual general meeting on Thursday, January 4, and elected a new executive for 2001.

Gina Hall was returned as President, with Marg Reichert as Vice-President. Anne Passey will serve another year as Secretary, and Debbie Schwarz as Treasurer.

Wayne Passey, Cubby Addison

and Loretta McDiarmid were elected for two-year terms as Directors.

Tulameen Community Club is currently looking at a project to put a roof on the skating rink. The cost of such a project is estimated at \$80,000, and the club has architectural plans in place for the project. They intend to apply to Sports BC for a grant.

Argo took avalanche threat "very seriously" says manager

Jim Richards, Operations Manager for Argo Road Maintenance, was distressed after reading the story, in the News Leader, of a motorist caught in an "avalanche" on Otter Valley Road. He told the News Leader that Argo took the matter "very seriously" and a complete review of the situation, and the number of messages, was done internally.

According to Richards, "A lot of money was spent on a major response to a single phone call." He states Argo received only one phone call from a person who said a motorist was trying to go up Otter Valley Road and there was snow in the way. The caller did not say there was an avalanche. Richards received the call at 8:30 p.m. on December

Richards said he called the man on the job that evening, who could not attend, so Richards then called the senior foreman, who drove out past where the caller had said the problem existed and ran into an area where the snow was two feet deep. The foreman decided to close the road, and contacted the Merritt end to have them close it. The foreman then called all people in the closure area who accessed the road. Argo contacted the Ministry of Highways at 11:00 p.m. to say the

snow was deep and there was a concern about possible avalanche problems, as there are known avalanche sites in the area. A helicopter was charted for daybreak the next morning, when an avalanche technician flew in to look at the road. This person saw tracks of where a vehicle had been stuck, but there was no avalanche.

Argo began plowing at 11:00 a.m. and worked until 9:00 p.m. that day.

Richards stated Argo inspects Otter Valley Road every 16 hours. The main road to Tulameen is a priority and is checked much more frequently.

Avalanches close roads

Roads to Tulameen were closed on Friday afternoon due to avalanches.

An avalanche at Red Bluffs, Princeton between Coalmont, blocked the road and had to be cleared. The road between Tulameen and Highway 5A (Aspen Grove area) was closed due to an avalanche which was soon cleared out, then closed again due to the threat of avalanche. An avalanche technician was called in to deal with the

The problem with avalanches occurred because of rain and higher temperatures following a period of heavy snowfall. The melting and the rain combined to create hazardous conditions. The Highways crew in Tulameen had received updated training and were alert and ready for the threat of avalanches in areas where they occurred in the past.



Laxpayers see small break in taxes

Personal and small business taxes have been cut, effective January 1, 2001. Basic personal tax credit will rise to \$8,000 from \$7,231 and spousal tax credit will rise to \$6,850 from \$6,140. Most other provincial credits and tax brackets will be indexed to prevent taxes from rising as inflation increases.

Provincial surtaxes will be incorporated into provincial income tax rates and tax-bracket thresh-

The tax rate on income between \$30,000 and \$60,000 will fall by half a percentage point.

The top marginal tax rate for personal income will fall to 48.7 per cent from 51.3 per cent, due to changes in provincial and federal income tax rates.

The threshold at which the corporation capital tax applies will rise to \$5 million from \$3.5 million. As a result, 90 per cent of businesses in B.C. will not be subject to the tax.



Pneumonia vaccinations are available

As of January 1, British Columbia's pneumococcal vaccination program was expanded to protect people aged two to 64 who are at risk from contracting pneumococcal infection. Pneumococcal diseases are life-threatening bacterial infections such as pneumococcal pneumonia, bacteremia and meningitis.

This provincial program has been available to all B.C. seniors aged 65 years or older, and is now expanded to protect younger people with chronic illnesses or those at risk of complications of respiratory tract infections. It is estimated the program will prevent eight to 21 deaths per year, hundreds of hospitalizations and thousands of doctor visits. Money savings are estimated to be between \$1.1 and \$2.8 million per year.

SAFER will not

subsidize gas bills

Seniors facing rent increases as a result of higher gas prices may be eligible for subsidies under the Shelter Aid For Elderly Renters program (SAFER). While the 20 year old program does not subsidize gas bills, it offers direct cash assistance to low-income seniors who pay more than 30 per cent of their income to rent in the private market.

Seniors may be eligible for SAFER if they:

- rent their homes and are paying more than 30 per cent of their income to rent,
- are 65 or older and are entitled to Old Age Security,
- are 60 to 64 and are either a Canadian citizen or a landed immigrant,
- * have lived continuously in

Canada for at least 10 years as an adult.

SAFER does not assist seniors who:

- · own their homes,
- live in manufactured homes or co-ops,
- live in subsidized housing or residential care facilities,
- · receive BC Benefits,
- have lived in B.C. for less than one year.

The Bridge starts new year

With Christmas holidays over and another year starting, it is time to start setting goals for the months ahead. These goals might include taking a course or even finishing high school. The Bridge continues to be an excellent place for adults to continue their education, whether they need to complete high school or upgrade for college entrance. However, it is also a great site for those who just want to take a course for their own interest.

The most popular reason for attending the site is still high school completion. All core subjects required for graduation are available along with a good selection of necessary electives. Although courses technically start at the Grade 10 level, students who need it are given plenty of assistance to reach this starting level. There are no classes and no timetable. Under a system of computer-managed learning, students are led through a path of assignments, tests, and quizzes for each course by a computer program. On-site instructors are available for help and one-on-one tutoring. It is up to each individual to determine how many hours per day they can work and when they will do it.

Because of the nature of the site, all Bridge students quickly

become familiar with the more common tasks that can be done on a computer - checking e-mail, scanning and mailing photos, opening and saving files, basic word-processing, etc. However, there are several computer courses that are offered on the site on a continual basis, such as Business Computer Applications 11. In this course, students learn the basics of word processing, databases and spreadsheets. BCA 11 will now use Microsoft Office Word 2000 as its core program. This is a great course to use as an elective as well as a useful stand-alone course for people who want to drop in to improve their computer skills.

Living Past 100

A simple pill for youth

There are some good effects in most people when they take synthetic DHEA, but there are dangers, too. If you have certain kinds of cancer cells in your body when you begin taking DHEA, you will trigger rapid growth of the cancer.

Here is the good news. Wild yam root powder is a natural organic product that does not give you DHEA, but it does contain a substance that helps your body produce more DHEA. In other words, you can buy this product cheaply at health food stores and many pharmacies, use the recommended dosage (never feel that more is better) and stimulate your body into producing its own anti-aging DHEA, which is a far superior source of the hormone. (If you really want DHEA therapy, you must ask your doctor for it and you will have to see an endocrinologist (a specialist in hormones and glands).

Biggest fish was two pounds.


He went back to McCaffery on 28th also and caught 11, releasing some. Most were 12 inches long.

Golf Club asks Council for grant

Princeton Golf Club asked Town Council for an additional grant of \$500 above the \$2,500 Council committed for an archaeological study done last summer.

OUR VIEW

Canada is not kind to the poor

Basic personal tax exemption has been increased to \$8,000. How many people live on \$8,000 per year or less? That works out to approximately \$660 per month, which is not exactly living high on the hog!

At the same time the exemption was increased, the tax rate for those earning \$30,000 to \$60,000 have their tax rate reduced by half a percent. In other words, those who earn \$2,500 to \$5,000 per month receive a tax rate reduction and those who can barely survive on less than \$1,000 a month may still be paying income taxes.

Is there something wrong with this picture?

The national poverty line is an income of approximately \$15,000 per year. Using the government's own calculations, the Revenue Canada people and the politicians have decreed that those who live under the poverty line must pay taxes. The government has agreed that the poor shall pay.

What happens if a poor person cannot come up with the money to pay? The people at Revenue Canada will freeze the person's bank account, even if the person is on welfare. According to a source in Princeton, this happened to a single mother here.

We Canadians have prided ourselves on being the kind of people who play fair, help others in need, and do our best to ensure a good life for every law-abiding citizen. However, our tax laws show clearly that we do not have much concern for the poor. Would it not have been more just to cut the tax rate for the poor and raise their basic personal exemption to at least \$12,000 per year?

Of course, any of us ordinary citizens do not have much influence with those who make the decisions at Revenue Canada, but we do have an opportunity to put the message across to our Members of Parliament, Talk to Mr. Day about this issue and use your influence.

Big Brother is watching you

We have all had the experience. You are standing at the cash register, making a retail purchase with your credit card, and you get the uncomfortable feeling the next person in line is standing too close, looking over your shoulder. Where it is a pack of cigarettes or a personal hygiene product, you feel your personal space and the confidential nature of your transaction information is being compromised.

You may be right. But you probably don't suspect the party who is really looking over your shoulder. It may be the cash register, the shopping club discount card, or the computer data banks it's all connected to, that is really invading your privacy.

Now that the holiday season shopping frenzy is over for another year, don't be surprised if you suddenly start receiving a raft of offers and inquiries from businesses you have never heard of. This may be one unpleasant result of the growth of information technology, where information passed to one business in one transaction is transmitted or sold to other businesses. Some

examples include pre-approved credit card applications from a company you don't normally deal with; solicitations from charities that got your name from another charity you once donated to; and direct mail advertising from companies that obtained information about you from a retail purchase made at another business.

Clearly, there are legitimate and illegitimate ways for businesses to use personal information acquired in the course of a commercial transaction. For me, two very key issues are whether individuals give companies permission to use their private, personal information and whether companies tell disclosed at the time of the transaction how they intend to use or share that information.

Many of us were brought up fearing the all-knowing, all-invasive, totalitarian state of George Orwell's political novel, "1984", where the power of the state surveillance, Big Brother, was used to observe every citizen's conduct.

Well, 1984 has come and gone, and Big Brother is watching you, but this time it isn't the government. In 2001, the real threat to personal privacy and the confidentiality of personal information comes not from big government, but from big business.

What is the appropriate role of govemment in the information age? The government of Canada will enact legislation to protect personal information held in the federally-regulated private sector. Provinces will then have three years to enact legislation that covers businesses under the provincial jurisdiction.

The B.C. legislature has struck a special committee on information privacy in the private sector. I am the chairperson of that committee. My role and my challenge as chair is to consult with business groups, interested citizens like you, and other stakeholders; to bring the parties together; and to balance the legitimate commercial interest of businesses with every citizen's right to privacy and confidentiality.

I hope to hear from you about this important issue.

Many of the New Age followers learn healing skills as if, by learning the skills, they could reach a higher level of soul development. This is the reverse of what most of the traditional mystery schools have taught. Those seeking spiritual development were told they could heal when spiritual development reached a sufficiently high level. Jesus was certainly proof of that concept, but there have been many spiritually developed people who were able to heal without being "schooled" in healing arts.

The requirement of traditional religion is to walk the path of the Master. It is no easy task to follow in the footsteps of Jesus, nor of any other person recognized as a spiritual leader or "master." Discipline is required (note the relationship between "discipline" and "disciple.") The discipline required is self-discipline, sticking to the rules, doing what is required even when it is inconvenient or even dangerous. Is this why traditional Christianity has lost its appeal - it is not easy


Wheelchair accesses need repairs


