Third female was Lynda Proce of Vernon, finishing 20th overall, with a time of 1:32:19.



Investment in Princeton's fairgrounds never seems to end. At the June 13 meeting of Princeton Exhibition Association (PXA), Treasurer Ruby Bey reported expenditures of more than \$8,000 for May, most of which was on a VIP building for the Rodeo Club, which will be recouped from money raised at the successful bullarama and pro rodeo held last month.

Town of Princeton gave the annual grant of \$3,000, and Princeton Community Forest Corporation pledged up to \$100,000 for future upgrading of the facility.

While expenses never stop, neither does the work. Nearly all of the work is done by volunteers. This year, to the date of the meeting, Rodeo Club members, PXA President John Bey, volunteer grounds manager Peter Ruoss, and two Katimavik members have prepared the grounds for the rodeo. Volunteers from Princeton

Motorsports prepared the grounds for their successful event on June 11, then worked on clean-up to help prepared for horse racing on June 30

Princeton Racing Days Association has been working since early spring to ensure the track and grounds are in top condition for the day of racing. Races begin at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, June 30. People have expressed regret that there is only one day of racing, but "one step at a time" was John Bey's response.

Once again, major media will attend the event. Their accommodation is sponsored by Princeton Castle Resort. Other sponsors have added money to the purse awarded to the winners.


Volunteers are needed




The Yes 2 IT initiative (Youth Exploring Skills to Industry Training) is an interactive hands-on activity for secondary students centered on skills used in trade careers.

PSS teacher John Kitts made application to the YES 2 IT group in order to receive grant monies to construct a garden shed with the aid of carpentry, roofing and electrical trades. The activity provides a student with awareness and exposure to different trade career opportunities.

Students participated in a preactivity by researching different garden shed structures, looking at building plans and assessing the costs of such a structure. Trades people from the community are brought in to work with the students and provide the technical skills. Parents also have assisted their kids in the development of the activity.

Upon successful construction of the garden shed, the garden shed will be sold and the school will receive a \$3,250.00 grant from the Provincial Government. Students will then participate in a post activity figuring out the actual costs associated with building the garden shed.

TRAVEL Kayaking with the Whales on Vancouver Island

Imagine five tons of Orca leaping from the water before submerging again below the watery depths. Now imagine this view while nestled within a nearby kayak.

It can happen -- especially if one is paddling in the Orca-rich waters of Johnstone Strait, off the east coast of Vancouver Island.

About 200 Orcas, or killer whales, are resident in the strait, in and around the Robson Bight Ecological Reserve. They come here for the salmon and, unique among Orca populations, to rub their bodies on the area's smooth stone beach-

Adventurers have a good chance of spotting Orca, as well as minke and humpback whales, porpoises, harbour seals, and sea lions from a kayak, or from one of the whale watching boats

that sail from Telegraph Cove, Port McNeill, Port Hardy and other coastal towns in summer.

Whale watchers and kayakers are also drawn to Vancouver Island's west coast to see one of the world's great whale migrations, when an estimated 22,000 Pacific grey whales travel along the shores here each spring, and to explore the Broken Group Islands and Clayoquot Sound -- two of the world's leading kayaking destinations.

The Broken Group Islands, part of the Pacific Rim National Park Reserve south of Ucluelet, are renowned for their clear seas and abundant marine life. Clayoquot (pronounced kla-kwat) Sound, north of Tofino, is a wilderness so biologically diverse it's been designated by UNESCO as a World Biosphere Reserve.

If visitors are short of time, kayaking and whale watching are still options. Whale watching boats leave Victoria, and nearby Sooke and Sidney, throughout the summer to look for the 80 or so Orcas residing in the area. These same seas, especially around the Southern Gulf Islands, are also ideal for easy kayaking.

And for a memorable excursion to end the day, adventurers can partake in sunset paddles, with a picnic on a beach and a chance to kayak off into the sunset, watching for Orcas along the way.

Victoria's Inner Harbour, home to such architectural marvels as the copperdomed Parliament Buildings and the ivy-draped Empress Hotel, still looks, in many ways, like an outpost of the British Empire.

Victoria's British roots do run deep, but there's a lot more to the capital's history than her colonial past.

Thousands of years more, in fact. The best place to see this is at the Royal British Columbia Museum, where exhibits scan several millennia of British Columbia history, from the last ice age to modern-day climate change.

Next to the museum is Thunderbird Park, home to several replica totems and a Kwakwaka'wakw bighouse still used for ceremonial purposes. Here one can also find Helmcken House, the oldest house in BC still on its original site, and St. Ann's Schoolhouse, one of BC's oldest schools.

Bastion Square, north of the Inner Harbour, is the site of the original Fort Victoria. It's now home to the Maritime Museum of BC. A few blocks north is the oldest and most historically intact Chinatown in Canada; it dates to the 1858 Cariboo Gold Rush, when Chinese immigrants comprised half of Victoria's

From Chinatown, travellers can hop a foot passenger ferry to Point Ellice House, a seaside Victorian home

with beautiful gardens and a massive collection of Victorian furnish-

ings. West of town, on the road to Sooke, is Craigflower Manor and its neighbouring schoolhouse, home to the oldest surviving school building in Western Canada. Nearby, at Fort Rodd Hill and Fisgard Lighthouse National Historic Site, one can see a coast artillery fort dating back to the late 1890s and the oldest permanent lighthouse on Canada's west coast.


Next door is Hatley Park National Historic Site of Canada, home to Hatley Castle, the 1908 estate of coal baron James Dunsmuir and now part of the Royal Roads University campus. The castle's landscaped grounds, fittingly, include Canada's only intact Edwardian garden.



Don't give your new relationship a gift from the past

(NC)-Up to one in five Canadians has genital herpes - one of the most common sexually transmitted infections. And most do not know they have it, or even understand how it is spread.

"Genital herpes has no cure and can cause painful physical symptoms," says Dr. Barbara Romanowski, Clinical Professor in the Division of Infectious Diseases, Department of Medicine, University of Alberta.

"It is important that people understand genital herpes and how it is spread so they can protect themselves and their partner."

Genital herpes is spread through skin-to-skin contact during vaginal, oral or anal sex and many people mistake it for something else, like a yeast infection or jock itch. Sometimes their symptoms - which may include blisters, bumps or rashes in the genital area, or on the thighs or buttocks - are so mild they go unnoticed.

Though the disease is most contagious during an outbreak, it is also

fact, in up to 70 per cent of cases, genital herpes is transmitted between partners when no signs or symptoms are present.

Preventing Genital Herpes: What you can do to reduce your risk. A number of things that can be done to lower your risk of transmitting or contracting genital herpes:

- Avoid contact with lesions (sores) during outbreaks. People who have the virus should avoid sexual contact with the affected area from the time they first feel any symptoms until the sores have completely healed. Consider other forms of intimate behaviour during this time.

- Use condoms at all times. As genital herpes is often spread when there are no visible signs of an outbreak, using a latex condom can reduce the transmission risk.

- Consider antiviral therapy. The effect of condoms and suppressive therapy may be additive. Daily antiviral therapy has also been shown to cut the transmission risk by almost half when used in con-

contagious between outbreaks. In junction with safe sex practices. Because condoms do not always cover the entire area where the virus may be present on the skin (e.g., inner thigh), daily antiviral therapy may also be considered to ensure maximum protection.

> Results vary from person-to-person, but studies have also shown that suppressive therapy can significantly reduce the frequency of outbreaks and, in some cases, prevent them from recurring for up to one year.

> Genital herpes can have a significant impact on a person's physical and emotional well-being - but it can be controlled. Healthy Seniors: Reduce the risk of falling at home

(NC)-Taking a fall in or around the home is the most frequently occurring accident for seniors, especially those coping with the symptoms of osteoporosis. In fact, some North American statistics list 'falls' as the seventh leading cause of death in persons over age 65.

The prevention of a fall on the other hand, or more importantly, preventing the injuries that result from a fall, is one of the best ways to delay the need to move to a long-term care facility, studies have shown.

"There are two major causes of falls in and around the home," says James Savage of Philips Electronics, the parent company of Lifeline Systems, well-known innovators in the emergency response field. "The first reason people fall is health- and age-related changes, such as poor eyesight, slow reflexes, problems with balance and use of certain medications. The second reason is dangerous situations, such as slippery floors, poor lighting, loose rugs, clutter, raised thresholds, and electrical cords in pathways. Most falls occur in bathrooms, bedrooms and on the stairs."

Lifeline Systems (www.lifeline.ca) produces an emergency response system to be worn as a pendant or a wristband, so that in seconds of an emergency any time of day or night, help can be on its way. To minimizethe risk of falling in your home, here's a sampling Lifeline's invaluable safety checklist:

- Use night-lights in the bedroom, bathroom and hallways.

- Keep a flashlight handy.

- Have light switches at both ends of stairs and halls. Install handrails on both sides of stairs.

- Add grab bars in shower, tub and

toilet areas.

- Use non-slip adhesive strips or a mat in shower or tub.
- Consider sitting on a bench or stool in the shower.
- Remove all extraneous clutter in your house.
- Keep telephone and electrical cords out of pathways.

- Tack rugs and glue vinyl flooring so they lie flat. Remove or replace rugs or runners that tend to slip, or attach non-slip backing.

- Ensure that carpets are firmly attached to the stairs.
- Use helping devices, such as canes, when necessary.

- Purchase a step stool with high and sturdy handrails. Do not stand on a - News Canada

chair to reach things.

- Store frequently used objects where you can reach them easily.
- Paint outside stairs with a mixture of sand and paint for better traction.

- Keep snow and ice off entrances and sidewalks.

- Review medications with your doctor or pharmacist. Some drugs, including over-the-counter drugs, can make you drowsy, dizzy and unsteady.

- Have your hearing and eyesight tested. Inner ear problems can affect balance. Vision problems make it difficult to see potential hazards.

- Exercise regularly to improve muscle flexibility and strength.







Receipts will be issued only on request.



What gets you up for the day? We attended the Crystal Meth Information Forum in Hedley last Thursday night.

It was a joint effort of the South Similkameen Anti-Crystal Meth Initiative (based in Keremeos), the Upper Similkameen Indian Band and RCMP.

It's not the first time we've attended such a meeting, but we learned a lot more about crystal meth than we probably thought we knew before the meeting started.

We are not afraid to admit to our own addictions. We are addicted to caffeine, chocolate and religion. If we got anything out of the Crystal Meth Information Forum, it was that we are in a pretty good place with our addictions. Others are not.

Meth - if you don't already know - is a pretty big problem. It's no longer a big-city problem as meth is so cheap to purchase (as little as \$5.00 for a 'baggie') and so addictive (you are hooked following your very first try) and that meth producers are packaging and aiming the drug at younger people (as young as 8-year olds are trying the drug in the Similkameen) that it really is something we can't pretend is just a phase that will eventually run it's course.

When meth runs it's course, it usually kills the users and destroys families. One user can affect far more than just a small circle of influence. Social programs, police and the whole community can feel the affects of just a single user.

Princeton RCMP Detachment Commander Kurt Lozinski said at the Hedley forum there are about 30 meth users in Princeton today. So far - to his knowledge - there are no meth labs operating in Princeton.

Even if you think you won't be affected as you don't 'associate with those types' or feel you are so far removed from the problem it can't touch you, we have news for you.

The problem already exists in Princeton. Even if you don't believe it - it does. What got our attention at the forum was the contamination issues associated with meth production and it's use.

Believe it when we say you are being affected by crystal meth and that you are probably being affected by it this very moment.

To find out more contact your local police detachment or visit the internet and Google your way through the maze of sites dealing with crystal meth.

You may have an a-ha moment.

It was enough to make us want to stick with our caffeine, chocolate and religion addictions.

Aboriginal Day is Summer Solstice

June 21 marks the summer solstice, the day when we enjoy the most hours of daylight. After June 21, we begin to lose a little daylight each day until December 22, which marks the winter solstice. The aboriginal people of Canada chose the summer solstice as a day to celebrate their heritage.

For many aboriginal nations, summer solstice held a special significance in addition to marking the peak daylight hours. It was a marker in time and seasons, but for many nations, it was a time of celebration. One nation, the Hopi, mark the day with a celebration much like our Christmas. There is a big tree loaded with gifts for children, and a big feast with dances to honour the old gods of nature, much like the pagan European winter solstice celebration replaced by Christmas.

There were 500 aboriginal nations in North America before the Europeans found the "new" continent. Not every nation held a summer solstice celebration, and those that did celebrate the day had their individual way of doing it. In Canada, Aboriginal Day is celebrated with festivals in some locations, while in others, it is simply a day to recognize their heritage.

Some people wonder why we bother with Aboriginal Day. Perhaps it would be more accurate to call the day "Founding Nations Day". Without the assistance of the aboriginal nations of North America, it is doubtful the Europeans would have been so successful in invading the continent. Imagine how difficult it would have been if, instead of being welcomed, the Europeans had been met with armed resistance at every port. Even after the Europeans settled, more often than not, they were shown how to survive by the skills learned from the aboriginal people.

The influence of aboriginal women who married Europeans continues to this day. There are millions of Canadians who are descendants of these women and who retain respect for the aboriginal side of their ancestry. Many early settlers build homes and raised families with their native wives in conditions few European women could have survived.

Picking summer solstice as the day to remember is appropriate for all Canadians with aboriginal ancestry as part of who they are today. For all Canadians, the aboriginal heritage has helped to shape our culture and make it unique, even as we try to right some of the wrongs done in the past to our First Nations people.

We take our aboriginal history for granted most of the time. For example, local place names are part of everyday life, but they are aboriginal names: Tulameen, Similkameen, Keremeos, Olalla, Osoyoos (properly pronounced uh-soo-yis), Penticton, Kelowna and Kamloops. We know the words "potlatch" and "powwow"and some of our oldtimers still call deer "mowich". We wear shoes called moccasins, and boots called "mukluks", and we prefer to wear "parkas" in winter. We know what a teepee is, and a peace pipe, and a war bonnet. Some people drive a Pontiac and may gas up at a Mohawk. Most of us never think of these words as "aboriginal". They are just part of our everyday lives.

On Wednesday, June 21, many First Nations people will mark Aboriginal Day by turning to Aboriginal People's Television Network (APTN) to watch the Aboriginal Achievement Awards. This is where the Nations are today.



It is so important to develop your faith. Why? Because faith is what connects you to the blessings of God. It's the force that gives those blessings substance in your life. He does not force Himself on you. He waits for you to give Him an opening by believing his word. When you believe his word and make your stand, even in the midst of the most impossible situations, God moves on your behalf. Remember faith speaks! But it doesn't say just any old thing; it speaks the word of God. When cancer attacks, faith doesn't say "I'm dying of Cancer." faith says "I'm healed by the stripes of Jesus" Therefore I'll live and not die and declare the works of God" - that faith mixed with His words give God and opportunity to work ... It gives Him something to work with! It gives him an opening - A window if you will! It's what you say continually that comes to pass in your life. So if you are believing God for finances, make it a habit to say things like this " According to Deuteronomy 28 Lack is a curse of the Law. Galatians 3:13 says Jesus has redeemed me from the curse of lack! All my needs are met according to God's Riches in glory by Christ Jesus." Then every time your bills come to mind call them paid in the name of Jesus, call yourself prosperous. Call yourself debt free. Call those things that be not as though they were.(Romans 4:17) Simply put, operate in faith - for faith connects you! Because God is good, His word is good and good all the time!

The 27 Garden Club members and guests, many of whom had dealt with the Bartletts in the past, kept Anna busy for 45 minutes before they ran out of gardening questions.


Potters Guild joins Arts Council

Three drivers fess up in Court

Three drivers appeared in Provincial Court in Princeton on June 15 to plead guilty to impaired driving charges.

Peter Boa admitted guilt in his first

appearance, saying he did not want to waste the Court's time, and apologized for his crime.

He was sentenced to pay a \$600 fine and a year's driving prohibition.

Local man clears slate

On June 15, Gary Renaud appeared in Provincial Court in Princeton to plead guilty to charges of growing marijuana, assaulting a neighbour and doing damage to lock-up property at the Princeton RCMP Detachment.

For possession of 46 marijuana seedlings and 36 adult plants, Renaud will serve an eight month house arrest with six months under curfew from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. daily except for work and church functions or emergencies. He may not consume alcohol or illegal drugs and he is to take recommended counselling.

He is further prohibited from owning firearms, ammunition or explosives for 10 years. Renaud assaulted a neighbour

who was spraying Renaud's dogs with water. Renaud struck him with a metal bar. He will pay a \$200 fine for this crime. For damaging public property at

For damaging public property at the RCMP lock-up, Renaud will pay a \$100 fine. Frank Tisdale, age 72, pled guilty to two charges of driving while prohibited as well as one impaired driving charge. He will pay a \$500 fine for each charge of driving while prohibited plus \$600 for impaired driving, and will serve a two year driving prohibition.


Danny Ladouceur entered a guilty plea to impaired driving on March 19, 2006.

Due to his driving record, he will serve a conditional sentence of house arrest for 75 days, during which he may not leave his residence between 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. In addition, he is not to consume alcohol nor non-prescription drugs during that period.

He is prohibited from driving for 18 months following his 75 day sentence.
