Interior Health Authority issued the following release January 2nd: Temporary Service Changes at Princeton General's Emergency Department

Residents are advised that during the month of January there will be times when the physician on call for Princeton General Hospital's Emergency Department will be attending only to the most urgent cases.

Emergency Department hours remain the same and patients will be

assessed as usual by our trained nurses. However, patients with less urgent needs may find they are either transferred to a nearby hospital for care, or offered appropriate options.

This change in service provision is expected to occur periodically through the month of January and is temporary due to current physician unavailability.



Who would have thought that when a northern chief went on a hunger strike it would spur a global indigenous movement? I have to admit that I had never heard of Chief Spence before her protest had started and I admit that I did not realize the extent of the omnibus bill. I am not surprised that the Idle No More movement has gained traction as fast as it has. We have watched movement after movement

pop up over the past few years all with similar messages so it is no surprise that the occupy movement has joined forces with Idle No More.

The question now is how far will this movement go? Will the Prime Minister meet with Chief Spence or will he ignore her? If he ignores her will she do as she says and starve herself to death? Will she become a martyr? The whole world is now looking at Canada and how the Prime Minister will handle Chief Spence's hunger strike. So will the Prime Minister meet with her? He might on the 11th hour but by then it may be too late for him to stop the actions that have already been set in motion. If Harper would have met with the Chief in the beginning, Idle No More may have fizzled out, but now the grass roots movement has legs of its own. Now Chiefs across the nation are starting to stir. If this happens the Prime Minister may have a national crisis on his hands. Like it or not, when the Crown signed treaties they recognized and legitimized the nationhood of those they signed treaties with. You don't sign treaties with an individual, you sign them with nations.

First Nations in this country have a long list of grievances and they run deep. This time Harper and his government have a real problem with an indigenous uprising. This time it is supported by many in the mainstream. This time it's not just "a bunch of Indians." There are non-first nations peoples standing side by side with the movement. Harper can't just wave this off. I am sure he will try but it won't work.

British Columbia is going to have an election this spring and I can almost guarantee that Idle No More will become a player in the election here too. The majority of first nations in British Columbia do not have treaties. Depending on what Harper does with the Northern Gateway pipeline and the way the BC Liberals deal with the decision at the national level we could see major protests.

I don't foresee 2013 being a politically stable year for governments across Canada. If I was a politician right now I would be weighing my options very carefully. The Harper Government is not going to back down on its stances. This will leave provincial governments holding the continued on Page 21

GRANTS IN AID

Application packages are available at Town Hall or on our website.



The Other Side of the Fruitcake

Last week I wrote about the people who thought the end of the Mayan calendar meant the end of the world. There is another side to the expectations of people who did not believe it was the end of the world, but did believe a new age of raised consciousness was beginning. They thought the special alignment of our solar system within the Milky Way would bring about some new higher vibration, so our consciousness would be raised. They are almost right.

Consciousness means awareness. Raising the level of awareness of the general population means the same thing as raising the level of consciousness. What many people seeking an elevated level of consciousness have failed to understand is that this process is a work in progress. It has been going on for approximately 150 years. The raised level of consciousness may or may not be related to the position of our solar system and the Milky Way, but there is plenty of evidence to show the level of consciousness in our world is being raised continuously.

If we look back at the American War Between the States, we see an elevation of consciousness about the wrongs of slavery. At the same time, in England, Charles Dickens was writing his weekly newspaper stories about the plight of the poor in his country. The unfair distribution of wealth led Karl Marx to propose Communism as a solution, leading to the overthrow of the aristocracy in Russia and the establishment of a system that ultimately failed, but certainly changed the old order. The same could be said for Communism in China.

The entire twentieth century was about raising consciousness. In Canada, people embraced trade unionism as a method of raising consciousness about the unfair distribution of wealth. This led to such innovations as worker's compensation, employment insurance, medicare and pensions.

We have become increasingly aware of injustices due to prejudice about race, religion and social position. World War II expanded people's thinking about other people on Earth because suddenly everyone was traveling to new lands as part of the war. We also had to face the depths of horror because of the Nazi death camps, and the Ukrainian starvation policy. We were confronted with the evidence that we were not as civilized as we believed we were.

During all of this time, there was an increasing awareness of injustice to women as they lobbied for the vote, for equal pay, for equal access to education, promotion, and credit.

During the twentieth century, we were increasingly exposed to truths about ourselves through psychology and sociology. We became conscious of the extent of sexual abuse of children, even by 'respectable' leaders of churches. We became more conscious of homosexuality, and more accepting of it. We became more conscious of violence against women and children.

These consciousness-raising trends continue. We are learning more truths about the corruption of our banking system and our corporations, and we have become fullyaware of how greed in those systems can force people from their homes into camps for the homeless. The homeless and the hungry raise our consciousness about the unfair distribution of wealth and the unfair taxation policies that allow the rich to keep a higher percentage of their money than the poor are allowed to keep, at least in most countries of the world.

Right now, our consciousness is being raised about the conditions many of our First Nations peoples endure and the refusal of our 'modem' government to honour treaties made with First Nations people. Right now, in India, people's consciousness has been raised about rapists.

During the past century, people became increasingly aware of our obligation to each other as human beings, partly because of our increased ability to communicate. We have not solved all of the problems, but we are increasingly aware of what the problems are and who is causing them.

While our consciousness is being raised, we must confront the fact that there are those who benefit by keeping us stupid and unaware. There has been a distinct 'dumbing down' of television and education during the past 20 years. There are forces at work to keep us from knowing the truth about many things going on in our world. At the same time, there are other forces, such as Independent Television Network and efforts like wikileaks to make sure we know the truth.

Science has led to raised levels of awareness, too. We have been forced to confront our own ability to destroy the planet on which we struggle to survive. We have been forced to pull the reins on some scientists who would launch nuclear weapons just to see what would happen.

Daily, we are forced to sift through thousands of bits of information to try to find the truth, because there are so many conflicting points of view.

Yes, we are entering a new age of elevated consciousness, but it is not an overnight happening, it is still a work in progress, and some people are not working at it, while others work against it.





What You Need To Know About Dementia

(NC)—Who hasn't joked about misplaced keys or a forgotten word being the onset of Alzheimer's disease? Don't kid yourself. Alzheimer's disease is a serious condition that will affect 1.4 million Canadians within the next 20 years, more than double today's figure.

Alzheimer's disease is the most common form of dementia. The term dementia generally refers to a group of brain disorders that are progressive and degenerative - and eventually fatal. It interferes with a person's ability to remember, think and process information.

The disease progresses differently in each person but will gradually make it increasingly difficult for a person to care for themselves and perform tasks or activities previously taken for granted.

Dementia is not a normal part of aging. It can affect people as young as 40, but the risk doubles every five years after age 65.

Some forms of dementia can be treated, even reversed. These forms result from medical conditions such as an infection or the side-effects of medication. But most types, including Alzheimer's disease, are still incurable.

A diagnosis doesn't mean a person has to change their daily routine or stop working immediately. But diagnosis is essential for getting the right treatment and support which will help people live more fully longer and will allow families to plan for future needs.

According to a 2011 Alzheimer Society poll, 50 per cent of Canadian baby boomers identified memory loss as the only sign of Alzheimer's disease, while a quarter couldn't name any sign. Do you know the symptoms? Changes in behaviour and personality can also indicate the beginnings of the disease.



Recognizing these signs is important for getting a diagnosis and to make the most of the available support and treatments:

• Memory loss - forgetting recent events or difficulty retaining new information

- Difficulty performing familiar tasks
- preparing a meal or shopping
 Language problems finding the

• Language problems - finding the right words or using inappropriate words

• Disorientation - getting lost on the way to work or being confused about the time of day

 Poor or decreased judgment neglecting personal hygiene or safety

 Problems with abstract thinking difficulty balancing a cheque book or not understanding what the numbers mean

• Misplacing things - putting things

in odd places like storing an iron in the fridge

 Behavioural changes - sharp mood swings, from calm to tears to depression that are hard to explain

You Can Still Thrive In Winter

Living Past 100

Many of us treat winter as if it were the plague. We avoid contact with the cold. This is not necessarily healthy.

Our homes become less healthy in winter, as they are closed, forced air furnaces blow dust, cooking creates a number of fumes. We need to be out in the fresh air.

Whether you choose to go for a walk, or go hiking or skiing, the fresh air will do you good unless you have some form of disease that prevents inhaling cold air.

Exercise has benefits year round, and using the cold as an excuse not to go outdoors to do things may be justified, but there is no excuse for lack of exercise just because the weather is cold. You can establish an exercise program in your own home if you want to avoid the cold, or you can go to the gym.

Becoming too cold is always a danger, but dressing properly for winter conditions is something every Canadian knows how to do. Avoiding frostbite or hypothermia is not an excuse for doing nothing all winter.

There are worse dangers by avoiding the cold and turning into a couch potato. If you are not exercising, you stress your body through weight gain, losing muscle mass, and losing flexibility. Exercise keeps muscles strong, and it is worth reminding yourself your heart and blood vessels are made of muscle tissue. Lack of exercise can kill you!

Even though the temperatures are below freezing, make time to go outdoors and breathe fresh air. Do not exercise to extremes in the cold, breathe through your nose or, if it is very cold, breathe through a scarf. Dress for the weather, but get out and move your body even when it is cold outdoors.

The better toned your body is, the less likely you are to become ill, and that is very important during the winter. Winter time is known for the spread of disease, and part of what makes some people susceptible to disease is lack of exercise. Exercise is good for the immune system, as well as for your muscles and blood flow.

On the good side of being outdoors in winter is the calming effect of seeing the magnificent winter landscape. A walk in the snowy world around you can lead to the discovery of scenes of beauty in places you never noticed during the rest of the year.







Kelowna broke the tie at 2:31 with a power play goal scored by Mitchell Barker with assistance from Jordan Salahor.


The third period saw both teams push and shove their way back and forth and saw more shots on goal from both teams (Kelowna 19, Princeton 15) than each of the previous periods.






