## iStan visits Princeton hospital

On May 26, iStan made a visit to the Emergency Room at Princeton General Hospital. Designed to provide an opportunity for health care providers to practice potentially lifesaving skills, iStan is the trade name of the 'most advanced wireless patient simulator on the market.'

As explained by Dr. Matt Petrie with the Interior Health Mobile Simulation Program, iStan "talks, blinks, breathes" and is capable of simulating a variety of scenarios that duplicate real life situations. Petrie was joined by Dr. Karla Tajik

and Colleen Brayman who formed the visiting Simulation Team.

Princeton health care professionals who participated in the program included doctors, nurse practitioners, registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, and paramedics. In the introductory comments, participants were encouraged to view iStan as a real patient and perform procedures such as taking a pulse, listening for heartbeat, checking blood pressure, and other clinical procedures that they would administer to a real person. ### Got Bats? Here's help

The BC Community Bat Project network is gearing up for another busy year. The 'Got Bats' initiative is a network of community bat projects established to raise awareness about bats.

A toll-free phone line and website provides information on managing bats in building, encounters with bats, and how to attract bats. Visitors to www.bcbats.ca will be linked to Okanagan Similkameen regional coordinator Margaret Holm.

"The Similkameen is definitely a hot spot for bats," said Holm.

"Last year there were calls from people who had established bat

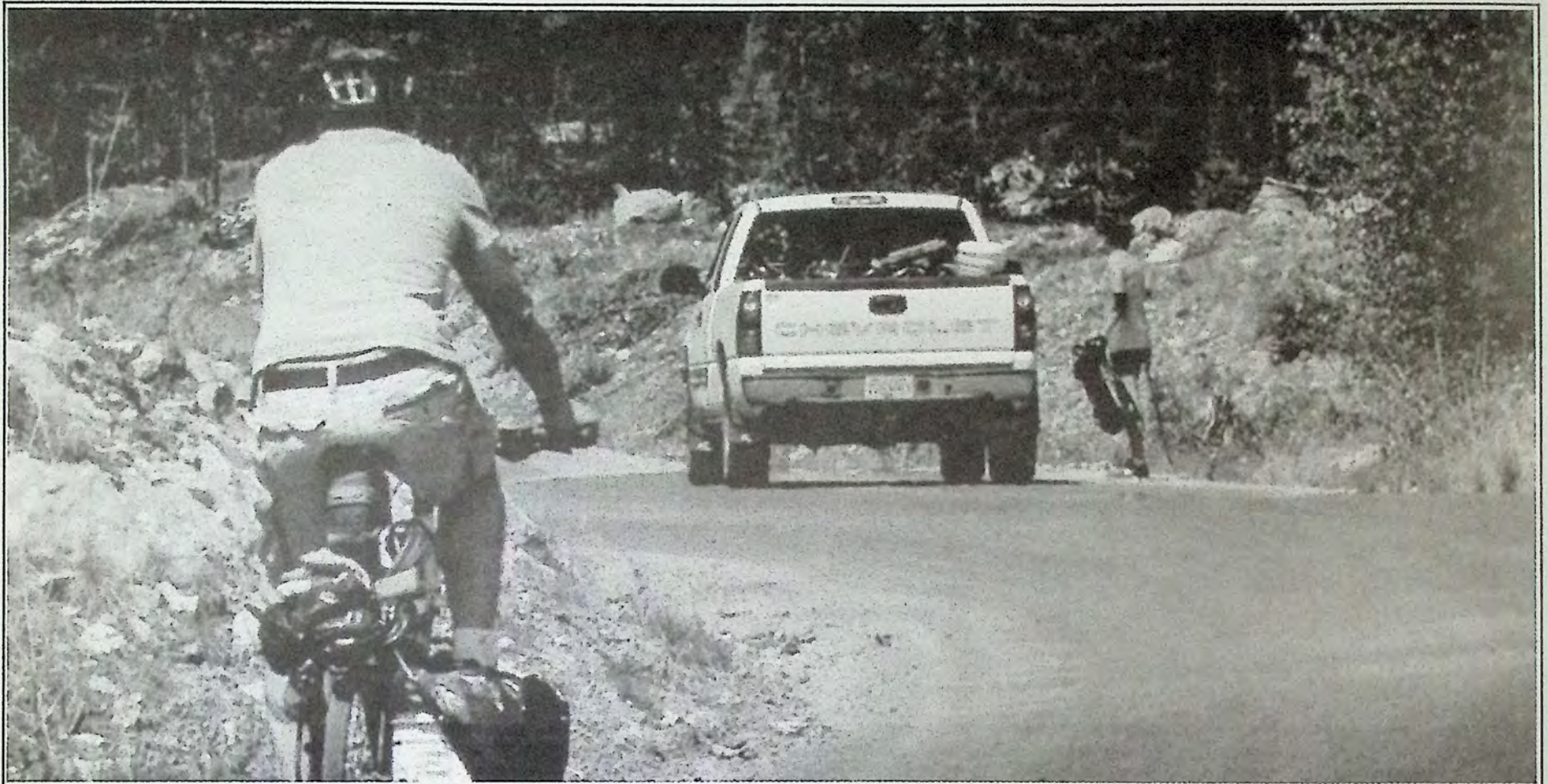
colonies in their homes and summer cabins and were happy to see the bats each year, while others wanted information on excluding bats. We offer information on both topics."

Of the 16 species of bats in the province, over half the species are declining and could become endangered. Recently the Little Brown Myotis, a species that often roots in buildings, was listed as Federally Endangered due to the devastating impacts of White Nose Syndrome in eastern Canada. This introduced fungus has killed approximately six million bats in North America. ....continued on Page 3

# Friend of Osprey Lake and Area H recycle

A solid effort was shown by 31 volunteers from the Chain, Link and Osprey Lake area for the 8th annual Roadside Cleanup on Saturday May 23rd. The weather turned out perfect for the cleanup and for the potluck supper that evening. Thank you to all who attended and helped us make this

event happen. You are the backbone of our community and a role model for others.

People hiked, biked, rode ATVs and drove in vehicles to pick up 430 kilograms/950 pounds of trash thoughtless others had tossed. We covered over 40 km of roads and Trans-Canada trails from Thirsk Dam to Jellicoe Road. Both Osprey and Link Lake Forestry Recreation sites were included in our litter con-


trol efforts. Two illegal dump sites were located and we removed some of the material found. We will be placing Illegal Dump Site signs at those locations and hope this will deter that behaviour in the future.

Collected materials for our cleanup included: metal, broken glass, material from a car crash, two 45 gallon bags of plastic, oil, paint cans, batteries a mattress and .....continued on Page 10

Why is Princeton not a destination? Princeton is a gateway, a gas stop, a grocery stop, but we are not considered a destination location. When I was a kid everyone knew where Princeton was. They had to stop here for gas going to someplace else, and if they came through in the summer, it was a stop at Frosty's or The Big Tee for an ice cream or burger. We need to stop being a fill up or supply stop and become that place people are going to.

A recent post by the Similkameen Valley's tourism Facebook page got me all worked up over this. The post was a link to the top places to stop between Vancouver and Kelowna. I guess I should be thankful there was Manning Park and Keremeos. At least they are in the Similkameen, but then it goes on to list Penticton and Skaha Lake, which makes sense as they are a

great stop over if you want to enjoy some sunshine, great food and coffee, but there was one other spot on the list that really made me stop and think and it was Osoyoos. Osoyoos is not even on the way to Kelowna unless you are up for adding an extra hour to your drive, but Osoyoos made the cut nonetheless. Where was Princeton? Why didn't we make the cut? At this point I am not even sure we are in the running for tryouts, never mind the cut. We lack the needed attractions in many areas to make the list. Keremeos has the fruit stands and the wineries. Manning Park has the ski hill, trails, lakes etc. which is similar to what we have to offer but there is nothing organized or marketed to say, "Hey, we have all that great stuff here in town too." We have done a really bad job at marketing Princeton as a place to go and do stuff. We have lots to offer, but right

now it is all being done individually and really lacks focus.

I am not going to list everything we have here because let's face it, you and I already know how great it is here. From China Ridge Trails and its cross country ski trails, snowshoe trails, bike and walking trails, China Ridge is a true gem and we should be promoting the heck out of it as a destination, but it has to be done as part of a bigger idea. The China Ridge group does a great job at marketing itself, but Princeton does not. Come to Princeton. Spend the day exploring the trails at China Ridge. Stay at Place X and enjoy a dining experience at Y. We do not show people that we can provide, not only something to do, but an experience.

My thing is history. When we travel, I drag my poor family to forts, steam ships, battlefields, museums, you name it. We have an amazing

museum here. But did you know that we have more than just a museum? We have rich railroad history here, but it has not been developed into a marketable product to bring people like myself here. Penticton has been celebrating Steamfest, and on May 30th it will be celebrating the 100th anniversary of the first train arriving in Penticton. Did you know that it has been 100 years since the first train came to Princeton? We have never taken the idea of turning our history into a marketable product to bring people to Princeton. Princeton is one of the oldest communities in British Columbia. If there was something big happening, it has happened here. Last week George brought up the need for accessibility to the roundhouse and caboose. We need

parking and an interpretive centre at that location. It is near the spot of the last spike of the KVR and yet we don't have anything that railroad enthusiasts can stop and look at.

There is a list of examples as long as my arm. There needs to be a clear direction on where Princeton wants to take this. Do we want to be a destination for people to stop at, or do we want to be a gas stop on the way to another place? I know my answer. I want to see us celebrate our history, the good and the bad. Let's celebrate our rich labour history that saw the birth of the labour movement in BC, the Gold Rush and how it changed our area forever. Let's celebrate our importance as a hub in the transportation

Since the disease is not thought to be in western Canada, community bat projects are doing all they can to promote bat conservation prior to its arrival.

Funded by the Habitat

Conservation Trust Foundation and federal Habitat Stewardship Program, and supported by the BC Conservation Foundation, the Okanagan Similkameen Community Bat Program is soliciting information on bats roost loca-

tions and can provide site visits and advice to residents with bats in buildings.

"We are encouraging people to report their bat colonies to the BC Bats program and to help by doing bat counts. This can provide important information on whether local bat populations are going up or down," stated Holm.

"Just relax in a comfortable lawn chair and count bats exiting a building just before it is fully dark. The bat program will provide count sheets and instructions."

### Proud To Be Treated Like A Local

The Town of Princeton has gone great lengths in recent months to promote the need to support local business. It was through their efforts (with support from the Chamber of Commerce) that business owners and operators were pulled together in regular meetings over eighteen months ago.

The intent was good and had solid footing.

Mayor Frank Armitage at the time said Town Council wanted to do whatever it could to help local business. The meetings inspired a series of articles I only planned to write for a short period of time I named 'Saving Downtown Princeton.'

I have credited Town Council for many good and bad moves over these months regarding their attempts to save the downtown.

The importance to saving the downtown core is greater than you may think. The lifeblood of any community, regardless of size, comes from its commerce. Without retail and service industry activity your community becomes a ghost town forcing everybody to spend their disposable income away from their home.

That was starting to become pretty obvious in the first set of meetings I attended and seemed to be a reoccurring theme. Part of the solution is to attract new people to your community but without the proper infrastructure (aquatic centre, theatre, whatever) some people just aren't interested in putting roots into Princeton.

As much as I have disagreed lately with some of the things that result from screaming matches in Town Hall, I do believe our 'leaders' are doing their best. It's not easy trying to build a community into a magnet after being neglected for so many decades.

The new Visitor Centre will continue to be what I will measure any other success of our 'elected' officials against. It will be, in my eyes, very hard to match that one.

That being said, they have screwed up pretty good a few times lately.

Using the poor air quality stats on the former Town Hall building as a reason to renovate the beaten courthouse into a new Town Hall was a stroke of genius. Well, until the air quality issues didn't seem to matter when the former Town Hall building was renovated to become a new Visitors Centre.

Requesting bids for municipal advertising in December was another brilliant, fiscally responsible move. Awarding all that advertising to a company that is not locally owned kind of contradicts their 'shop local, support local' battle cry.

Taking away the tourism component from the Chamber of Commerce was probably a good idea, at least on paper. It may push the Chamber into becoming a stronger force within the community putting Town Council to task on such things as bylaw amendments, zoning issues and a whole can of worms the Chamber can now stir up. I'm betting that's what will happen and from where I'm sitting, it will be the best thing to happen for both sides.

In any government-run society there is an Opposition that, in theory, is there to keep the 'leaders' in check. I view the new Chamber of Commerce as filling this role. Then you'll see what it really means to support your community.

### Letters and E-Mails Received This Past Week

To The Editor;

In his latest MP Report, Dan Albas remarks on 'allegations' the federal government muzzles federal research scientists, saying scientists at the two federal research facilities in our region have never made similar complaints to him.

I think any scientist would agree that a lack of anecdotal evidence expressed in a limited number of conversations doesn't mean that no evidence exists.

Across time, numerous government scientists have said they've been barred from speaking freely about their research. In one case, scientists at an international polar conference in 2012 were not allowed to speak to the media unless government employees were in attendance to monitor and record what they said.

It's perhaps understandable why Agriculture Minister Gerry Ritz interrupted one scientist and had him swept off stage, again in 2012. George DaPont, president of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency,

had been speaking about an extensive beef recall when Ritz intervened.

It's harder to imagine why Scott Dallimore, a Natural Resources geologist, needed government approval to talk to journalists in 2010 about his study of a flood in Northern Canada almost 13,000 years ago.

The Canadian Science Writers' Association explains the Harper government introduced media policies in 2006 to control not only scientists, but also journalists. Interviews and often the questions to be asked are now vetted ahead of time, and are sometimes denied outright or unduly delayed. In one instance, a request from The Canadian Press to interview Max Bothwell about his work on algae resulted in 110 pages of e-mails between 16 different government communications officers. The CP article went to press before Bothwell could be interviewed.

Just this month, recently retired Fisheries and Oceans Canada biologist Steve Campana described a

research finding that he and his team were not allowed to disclose in Canada. One of his colleagues presented the work at a U.S. conference, and the story was published by 127 media outlets in 25 countries.

Trying to explain the clamp-down at home, Campana said he didn't think it was as simple as science conflicting with government policy. "It's hard to fathom," he said. "It seems to be simply a control issue."

Late last year, more than 800 scientists from 32 countries called on Harper to end "burdensome restrictions on scientific communication and collaboration faced by Canadian government scientists." Canada's leadership in basic research, environmental, health and other public science is in jeopardy, they said.

The clamp-down has also meant "a loss for the international science community."

## Hawaiians Fought Big Money, Politics

During the November 2014 elections, Maui voters won a resolution temporarily halting Monsanto and Dow from proceeding with a plan for experimental work in Maui pending full disclosure of activities planned. An investigation was to take place to determine everything the corporations were doing in Maui. Believe it or not, the Maui County government joined with the two major corporations in an effort to nullify the vote.

The matter was kicked up to federal court, not the State of Hawaii court. The first judge appointed to the legal challenge was replaced (his wife had close ties to an organization receiving major financial support from Dow). The second federal judge delayed hearing the case pending two matters to be presented to the American Senate, but the two matters had missed the hearing deadline. In effect, the case was left in limbo temporarily. In April, the court proceeded.

Monsanto submitted documents in court to support their position. They requested that the entire doc-

uments not be made available to the voters' lawyers. Some sections of the document would remain unavailable to the voters' lawyers. The judge agreed to allow some sections of the documents not be revealed to the voters' lawyers.

The voters' lawyers requested documents outlining what Monsanto has been doing in Maui, e.g. experiments, products used, etc. This was denied by the court.

The judge ruled the case of the voters' resolution would go to federal court, bypassing the State of Hawaii. The State of Hawaii has adopted a policy of protecting the environment and future generations from anything harmful. Moving the case to federal court effectively moves the matter beyond influence from the state's own legislation.

The court fight in Maui is to uphold the voters' resolution, and it is a critical case because similar attempts in Kauai and other islands have been defeated.

The reason the voters are putting so much effort into this battle is due to what they feel are excessive amounts of pesticides being sprayed on the islands' farms without the public knowing what is in the sprays and the combined effect of those sprays impacts people and other species of plant and animal life of the islands.

This court battle has received no attention from the major media, yet it could be critical for all of us to know all we can about it. All of us are faced with making decisions about what we want in our environment. The attempts in Hawaii represent a clash between the people, the politicians and global cor-

porations. It would appear the people want one thing, but politicians and the corporations want another, and the key factor will determine whether the people will have their way.

One of the foundations of democracy is respect for the majority vote. The voters of Maui won majority support for their resolution, yet it appears everything possible is being done to prevent them from winning the right to know exactly what Monsanto and Dow are doing to their environment.

Let me make the battle clearer. By definition, a corporation is an entity, just like you and me. A corporation is a 'person' by law. What we see in Maui is two 'persons' refusing to comply with the will of the majority of 'persons.'

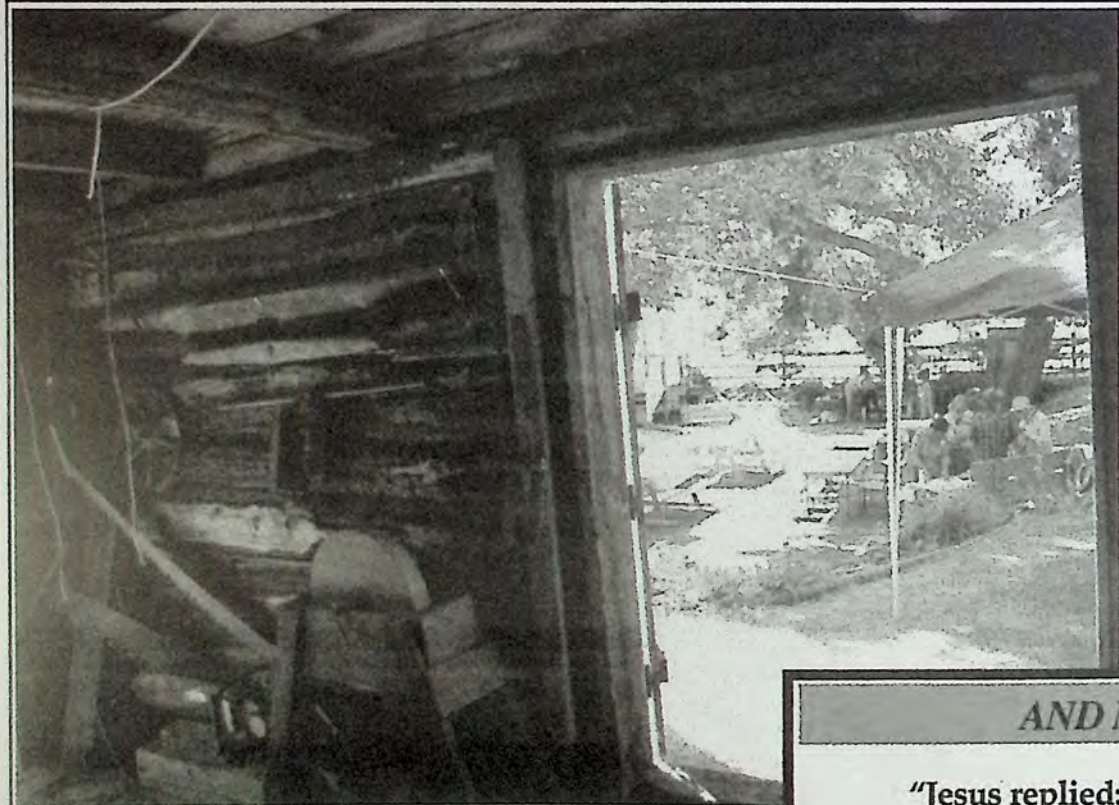
The next court date is June 15, 2015.

### TRANS PACIFIC PARTNERSHIP (TPP)

Twelve nations have entered into negotiations on a trade deal which would embrace Pacific Rim countries. Meetings have taken place in April and May with the next scheduled meeting in Guam this month.

# Art For Health dominates meeting discussion

The Princeton Health Care Steering Committee (PHCSC) held its regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, May 19 at Princeton General Hospital. The meeting was

attended by representatives from the Town of Princeton, Area H (RDOS), health care practitioners, Interior Health, and SOHC.

The 'Art for Health' Working

Group presented a budget and reported that the artists for the first four projects are ready to begin their work. For the Japanese garden at the main entrance Fletcher TimberMart

Princeton Building Supplies has donated 14 bags of white landscape stone and Nienke Klaver has donated the Japanese stone lantern. Work on this project will be completed shortly.

The second project will be a painted mural by Merrillyn Huycke on the east wall of the waiting room in the main entrance. In preparation for this work, arrangements have been made to have the vending machines removed. Susan Delatour has begun work on the third project which involves the replacement of old existing prints with new artwork.

The fourth project will be a ceramic tile mural by Edward Staples and will be located on the west wall across from the nurses station. The Working Group has plans for other aesthetic improvements that will be presented after the first projects are completed.

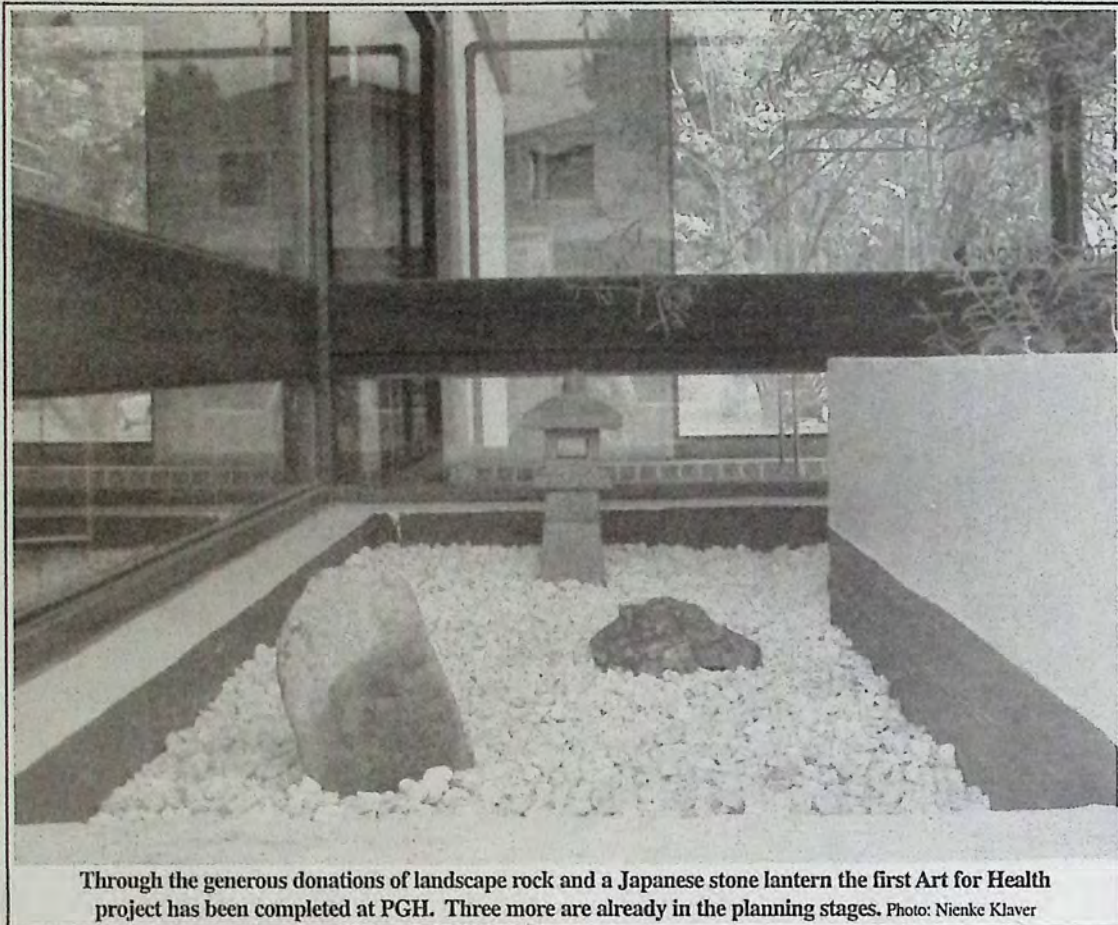
Dr. Ella Monro reported on several initiatives led by the practitioners at Cascade Medical. Starting in

August, the physicians will be supervising a third year Medical student which is hoped will lead to other students coming to Princeton in the future. ## iStan visits Princeton hospital

.....continued from Front Page demonstrated that during a simulation iStan would be wirelessly monitored and his clinical signs would

change automatically as he responded to treatment.

In the first simulation, paramedics with BC Ambulance Services con-

tacted the hospital to let them know that in five minutes they would be arriving at the ER with a 40 year old male involved in a motorcycle accident, that he was conscious but not coherent. One doctor, two RNs and one LPN responded to the delivery. The team put iStan through a series of tests and administered procedures in an effort to stabilize the patient for eventual transport to Penticton General Hospital. An additional doctor and nurse were called in to assist and the High Acuity Response Team in Penticton was contacted by telephone. Lab technicians were brought in to take x-rays and take blood tests.

The simulation concluded with a debriefing session where participants shared their thoughts. There was general agreement that patient simulation provides excellent exposure to clinical experiences that are complex or difficult to obtain. The experience was considered to be very valuable and provided an opportunity to promote patient safety through the process of self-reflection and assessment.

This training session was sponsored by the practitioners at Cascade Medical.

### Living Past 100

#### Avoid Toxic Pine Needle Tea

There have been many articles about the benefits of pine needle tea. Many British Columbians may have been interested in making the tea as there is an abundance of pine trees in this province. However, the kinds of pine trees most common in British Columbia are not suitable for making pine needle tea. Anyone who goes out and collects the needles of lodge pole pine or Ponderosa pine (Yellow, Bull pine) and makes a tea from it will discover it is toxic. That is, it will make you sick.

There are many such natural cures for ailments. Using herbs, berries, leaves and roots of wild plants is what we call traditional medicine, but doing it yourself can be dangerous. You need an expert who knows just how to use these plants. Many traditional medicines are made from materials gathered at a certain time of year, or a certain phase of the plant's cycle. The other key factor is knowing in what form to use the plant, and how much the dosage should be.

Many plants are toxic. Humans were never intended to eat them. In fact, plants such as datura (loco weed) were used to create intoxication and are lethal in more than tiny amounts. Fortunately, most of the loco weed in southwestern British Columbia was removed by early settlers who saw their livestock poisoned by the plant.

There are many books on medicinal herbs. These books describe the plants and their uses as well as how to prepare the teas or poultices. Good books on medicinal herbs give full colour photographs of the plants in question. Many books provide only line drawings, and mistakes can be made.

In any location, some plants will be similar to, but not exactly the same as, the plants named in the book. This, too, can create problems. A plant grown in a moist location on the coast can be quite different from the same plant grown in an arid environment.

It is always wise to proceed with caution when considering making your own medicinal preparations. If you would like to know more about how to do it, study herbal medicine or consult a certified herbalist.

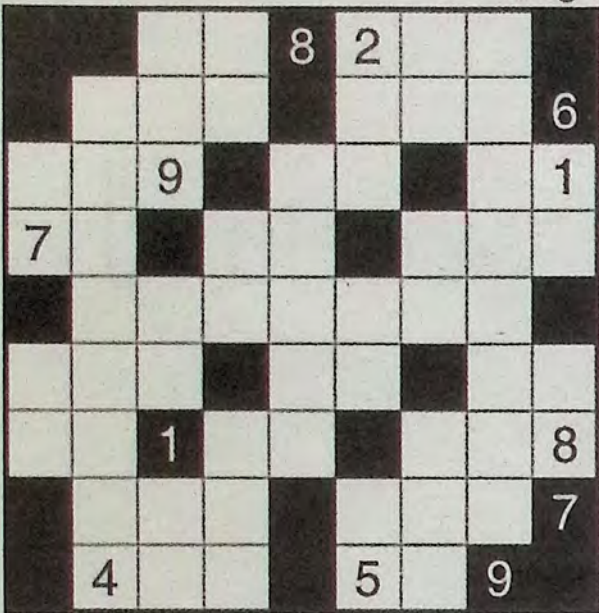

# Saving Downtown Princeton...

## ...An Ongoing Series by George Elliott

One of the things that I think really hurts downtown business, and the entire community, is what you find online about Princeton.

There are some pretty good sources travelers rely on when going somewhere and if you ever visited some of them and looked up reviews on Princeton accommodations and restaurants you would do just about anything to avoid this place. I have taken it upon myself to try to balance the negative reviews by posting positive reviews. I have

started doing this on TripAdvisor by posting positive reviews of local businesses I have had positive interactions with.

If you own a local business and I have not had a positive experience in your place of business, fear not. My goal online is to promote my community in a positive manner. I will also start posting reviews on Yelp! as well.

It really frustrates me to see the damage a bad review can cause a local business owner.

I have even discussed reviews I have found with a handful of local business owners. I personally feel that it is far easier to post a complaint and remain virtually anonymous than it is to complain and post your contact information. That's not fair, especially if the business did not deserve to be poorly reviewed.

I also know that some of the negative reviews are rightfully deserved, but so are compliments and I encourage you to share positive experiences with local businesses with others when they happen to you. Human nature seems to push us willingly to complain longer and louder than complimenting. It's just how we are and I am trying in one way to make a small difference.

Using Spencer's observations last

week about the digital world becoming more and more the choice of many for travel information I'm looking at hitting that first.

I will say that although there are some downright nasty online reviews about Princeton businesses, there are also some great pieces of constructive criticism. Also, as Spencer mentioned last week, there is a need to become part of the dialogue if we want to communicate what our community is about to the outside world.

One of the best examples I have found about engagement is the reviews posted on TripAdvisor about the Princeton Sandman Inn. Each and every comment receives a response and not some standard 'thank you for your feedback, we

value your comments' type answer. Each of the ones I read last week fully addressed concerns and offered positive reassurance that complaints were important in the process leading to improvements.

I was very impressed.

I know I have indicated in the past that we don't use these kinds of online tools to find the best place to stay or eat based on a five star system that can easily be skewed. Instead, we ask people in the community we visit for that information. We have met with much success using this method and have discovered a couple of 'must-go' places on our list whenever we visit these communities.

We also get asked these questions often in our office. We always send visitors to a restaurant or coffee shop in town that we think is the perfect match for what they are looking for. We don't care if that business supports us or not because

"It was great to see him and we started sharing stories of the 'old days' and I learned a little bit more about Bobby Lind's hospitality skills he shared with our friends from Tonasket when the Pony Express Friendship Ride was still going on."

The future of the Sister City relationship is still questionable with so many of the original and early members passing on. "Bert sounded pretty worried about whether or not a younger generation would pick up the torch and run with it," Elliott says. "They are facing the same problems we are here and that is that the volunteers who put on these events are getting older and want to take a rest but there doesn't seem to be enough new people interested in taking these projects on."

One of the most noticeable turning points in the Sister City relationship has come from City of Tonasket Mayor Patrick Plumb. He has put a lot of effort into trying to keep the relationship alive because he sees value in the connection.

Once the Chamber of Commerce figures out their new role in the community, I think they could give all local business a boost by having members register for free accounts at TripAdvisor, Yelp! and wherever else and start by posting positive reviews about Princeton area businesses. The value in doing this will go much farther than you can imagine.

How does this help save downtown Princeton?

As easy as it is to post 'phoney' or nasty reviews online because you either don't like a business owner or had a bad experience, it is just as easy to post positive compliments online. If we all chose to get past the bad experiences and focused on sharing the good ones for a change, it will give out of towners a different view of our community when researching it online.

Reading online reviews that encourage you to visit will put Princeton on the 'must stop' list rather than 'must pass' list for many travelers.

"It's because of Patrick that Brenda and I visit Tonasket again - I had lost my interest years ago and didn't have a passport until two years ago," Elliott explains.

"I met him here during Racing Days weekend and we hit it off right away. He connected Brenda and I with friends of his and now we're all in regular contact with each other and get together frequently."

Both Elliott and Plumb see potential in the Sister City relationship by pushing it into the future and one way that has happened is through connections made between Youth Ambassador Candidates and Ambassadors from recent years.

Other plans include putting together some kind of cross promotion where both communities would benefit from building on their already established connections.

"In some circles it just isn't an easy sell, I'm not sure why more locals in both communities don't see the value in a cross border relationship. It's not just in Princeton, either. Whenever we are in Tonasket we like to say we are from 'your Sister City' and we get a few blank stares but other times we get recognized as soon as we enter some businesses. The one thing we notice most is that whether or not they know where Princeton is, everyone wants to know more about us and are so welcoming. For

a community a fraction of the size of Princeton they are 'tourist friendly' and show it."

Elliott says he sees the same thing happening more and more in Princeton as well. He credits active town leaders for getting these messages through to merchants.

"The Tonasket and Princeton Chambers of Commerce are quite similar facing the same problems but they haven't given up and I think if I took anything away from Tonasket last weekend is that from Bert Beeman and the rodeo club to the Mayor's office and the Chamber of Commerce is that as tough as it is to see a fruitful future, no one has given up on their community."

Elliott says that same spirit is alive

in Princeton as well, although sometimes it may not be as obvious.

"I think as frustrating as it is to be a small town business owner at times, I see all my neighbours on Bridge Street doing what they can

to keep their businesses afloat. Even if it seems hopeless at times and we're still waiting for Town Council to toss us all a bone every so often, none of us have given up."

That alone makes the Sister Cities tighter than before.

## Edith Rice and the Overwaitea Timbers

The old Princeton Overwaitea building has been demolished. They started the Friday before Mother's Day and they took pains to save the big beams and stack

them carefully to the side. Who knows how far those will survive into the future and what new history they will embody.

Overwaitea has been in Princeton since the thirties. The first store was on the corner where the drug-

store now is, and it was there all through WWII. The second store was on Vermilion about where the museum is now, and that location lasted until the big new store was built on Bridge Street.

Edith Rice saw the construction of

that building and she remembers some of the people who used to serve her there. Maria Sadegur worked in the new store. And Judy Robertson worked in the Vermilion store and was an employee until she retired. But it was seeing those big timbers that really brought back memories.

Edith lived at the Roany Creek Ranch with her husband Eugene Rice where they operated the E.C. Rice Logging and Sawmilling Company. Eugene passed away in 1999, but Edith is still there and the mill, under the same name, is now operated by their son Ernie Rice.

The original mill was built by Eugene in 1952. Edith says, "it was more of a tie mill," meaning for cutting railway ties. In 1965 Eugene rebuilt the mill to a larger version. He did a lot of the work himself, like the panograph and live rollers, but the actual carriage part was built in Penticton. Custom sawing became his specialty, and that's what Ernie still does there.

It was in 1968 before the snow when they got an order from the contractor for those huge beams that went into the Overwaitea building. The beams were 32 feet in length, the longest they could cut. Nobody else in the area could handle lumber that size. Edith remembers taking the invoice to

the building site and they had already put the timbers in place. "This would have been fir, pine is not strong enough. The inspectors wouldn't have passed it otherwise." It is interesting to note that trees big enough to produce timbers that size would have started growing in the century before Canada's confederation.

The Overwaitea beams came from the Roany Creek Canyon, which is where Eugene was cutting at the time. He would have bid on lumber and got forestry permission. "It was quite a process - lots of paperwork," Edith said, adding "Once we had a rail car of lumber destined for Africa - through some lumber broker. There was sure a lot of paperwork for that."

Eugene also cut lumber for customers in the Lower Mainland and Vancouver. He always left at night so he'd be there with the order in the morning. One time he was to go down with a load of wood but the order wasn't quite finished, so he had to phone down to say that he'd be there the next day instead. That was the night of the largest land slide in Canadian history. The famous Hope slide. Had the order been finished, he would have been right about there when the slide occurred, and the history of the Roany Creek Ranch and Sawmill would have turned out quite differently.

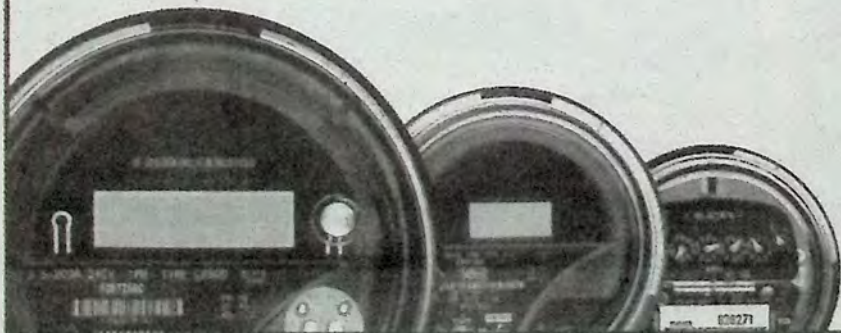
