He was surrounded by family for his passing and expressed great gratitude for all of his family.

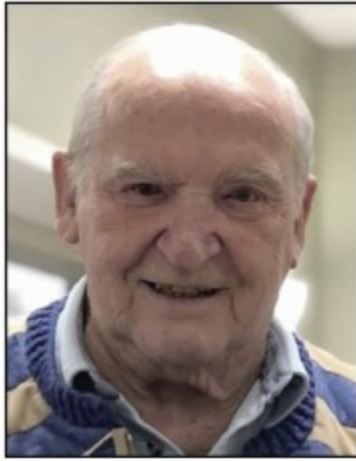
