PRINCETON—John James Taylor, 76, logger and sawmill operator, has died here.

Born in Ontario, he came to B.C. at the age of 17 to log in the Golden area. He moved to **Princeton** in 1924 and rebuilt the De Muth sawmill, now the Kettle Valley Sawmill.

In 1938, Mr. Taylor and his sons built a sawmill three miles south of **Princeton** which the sons continue to operate.
