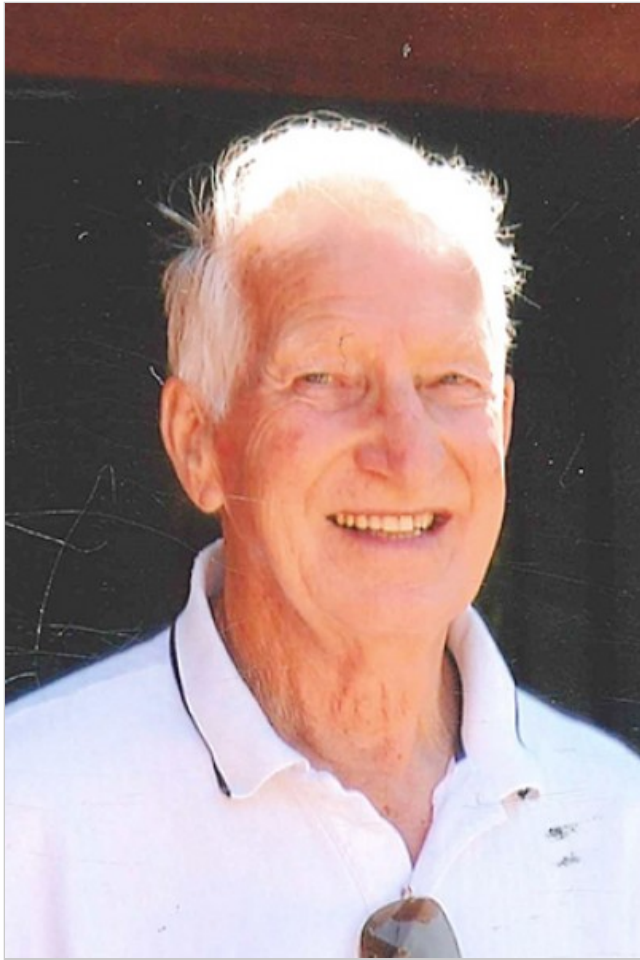


Terrence Hardin
